According to the Iowa Electric Safety Code found in Iowa Administrative Code Chapter 199-25.2(3)b., your Iocal electric cooperative/utility may refuse to provide electric service to any grain bin built near an existing electric line which does not provide the clearances required by The American National Standards Institute (ANSI)C2-2017 "National Electrical Safety Code," Rule 234F. This paragraph "b" shall apply only to grain bins loaded by <u>portable</u> augers, conveyors or elevators built after September 9, 1992, or to grain bins loaded by <u>permanently</u> installed augers, conveyors or elevators built after December 24, 1997. (As adopted by the Iowa Utilities Board)

Utilities Board) Dairyland Power Cooperative is required by the Iowa Utilities board to provide this annual notice to farmers, farm lenders, grain bin merchants, and city and county zoning officials.
