Discussion was held regarding the sewer issue at 665 Cottonwood Avenue. Motion by Marline Lewerke, seconded by Don Bell to affirm \$7,733.25 be charged to the property owner, carried unanimously.

Motion by Marline Lewerke, seconded by Don Bell to rescind and revise the previous motion to waive \$750 of City vactor fees and charge \$6,983.25 to the property owner at 665 Cottonwood Avenue, carried unanimously.

Motion by Denny Drabek, seconded by Glen Juhl to approve the claims as submitted, carried unanimously.

Discussion was held with GVAS staff regarding amending the 28E Agreement to allow a potential fulltime employee to be covered under the City of Garner's health insurance plan. Direction was given to staff to move forward with amending the 28E agreement.

time for the Public Hearing regarding adopting the Code of Ordinances. He asked for comments from the floor, CA gave an update on the process. Hearing no further comments, Mayor Mick closed the public hearing and the following action was then taken:

CA Kofoed presented an update on the Pool Park Shelter House including getting bids on chairs and a timeline to begin taking reservations. Due to COVID restrictions, Council consensus was to revisit when to begin taking reservations at next month's meeting.

Drew Sweers with V&K gave updates on The Reserve Phase II, the Red Elevator, Hwy 18 Trail and Hejlik III final items including Yates' fence.

No action was taken regarding the hire of the Assistant Parks and Recreation Director.

Discussion was held regarding a full-time Chamber employee being covered under the City of Garner's health insurance plan as they are in the process of hiring a new Director. Deb Schmidt and Lori Fank, representing the Chamber, were present to discuss the situation. They would like to have a workshop between the City and the Chamber after the first of the year.
