**Hancock County Board of Supervisors June 20, 2022 Garner, Iowa**

The Hancock County, Iowa, Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on the above captioned date pursuant to adjournment with Supervisors Florence (Sis) Greiman, Gary Rayhons, and Jerry J. Tlach present. Absent: none.

The minutes of June 16, 2022 meeting were read and approved.

A public hearing was held on Ordinance no. 31, An Ordinance Regarding the Disposal of Solid Waste, Garbage, Refuse, Recyclables or Yard Waste and Designation of Landfill of North Iowa as Disposal Site. Those present for the hearing were Supervisors Greiman, Rayhons, and Tlach, Deputy Auditor Jolene Learar and County Engineer Jeremy Purvis. There were no other comments received, no objections received. On motion by Supervisor Rayhons to close the public hearing, seconded by Supervisor Greiman All ayes.

## PROCEEDINGS

### GARNER CITY COUNCIL City of Garner Proceedings of June 28, 2022

Mayor Tim Schmidt called the meeting to order at 5:30 PM. In attendance were Councilpersons Marline Lewerke, Amber Jenniges, and Don Bell. City staff present were City Clerk Kelly White, Street Superintendent Mark Waddingham, Officer Josh Trulson, and City Administrator Jim Collins.

A motion was made by Lewerke and supported by Bell to approve the agenda. Motion carried 3-0.

Chamber Director Rebecca Olson presented Council with a requested list of road closures for the Duesey Days celebration.

A motion by Jenniges to approve the consent agenda which consisted of the minutes of June 13 & 14, Garner Chamber Class B Beer Permit, Kwik Star Class C Beer Permit, Matt's Place Class C Liquor Permit, and the appointment of Bill Mack to the Board of Adjustment was supported by Lewerke. Motion carried 3-0.

A motion by Jenniges to approve Resolution 2022-47, a resolution directing the clerk to publish notice of hearing on the adoption of Ordinance 461, an ordinance adding section 165.35 to the Garner, Iowa, Code that limits ground mounted photovoltaic systems was supported by Bell. Motion carried 3-0.

A motion by Lewerke to approve Resolution 2022-48, a resolution approving adjustment of the pay scale and setting salaries or wages for the appointed officers and employees of the City of Garner for fiscal year 2022-2023 was supported by Bell. Motion carried 3-0.

Mayor Schmidt opened the Public Hearing for the 2022 Addition to the Garner Urban Renewal Area 5:52 PM. No written or oral objections where submitted. Mayor Schmidt closed the hearing at 5:43 PM.

A motion by Jenniges to approve Resolution 2022-49, a resolution to Declare Necessity and Establish an Urban Renewal Area and Approve Urban Renewal Plan Amendment for the Garner Urban Renewal Area, was supported by Lewerke. Motion carried 3-0.

A motion by Lewerke to approve

Resolution 2022-50, a resolution directing the clerk to publish notice of hearing on the Plas-Tech Tooling Tax Increment Financing Development Agreement, was supported by Jenniges. Motion carried 3-0.

A motion by Jenniges to approve Resolution 2022-51, a resolution approving contract and bond with Bob McKiness Excavating and Grading for the Reserve Phase 2 Project, was supported by Bell. Motion carried 3-0.

A motion by Lewerke to approve Resolution 2022-52, a resolution authorizing the City Administrator to approve change orders to the 2022 State Street Reconstruction Project up to \$15,000 was supported by Jenniges. Motion carried 3-0.

A motion by Lewerke to approve Resolution 2022-53, a resolution approving the hire of summer & VMRC Front Desk employees and setting hourly rates of pay, was supported by Bell. Motion carried 3-0.

A motion by Jenniges to approve Resolution 2022-54, a resolution approving the hire of Brett Bulson as Assistant Park & Rec Director and setting Brett's hourly wage, was supported by Lewerke. Motion carried 3-0.

Council Directed Collins to proceed with Homes for Iowa application to buy one home.

Larry Young expressed interest in buying City real estate property described as MARV RAYHONS SUB LOT 4. Council did not have interest in selling at this time.

Drew Sweers reported that the Highway 18 Bike Trail will be submitted for IDOT bidding and the Reserve II project is scheduled to begin in August.

Council directed Collins to have Crown Point Builders remove the concrete and tree stumps at the Reserve II project site.

Mayor Schmidt directed staff to increase marketing of the Fuller Drive properties.

Being no further business, a motion by Lewerke to adjourn the meeting at 6:15 pm was supported by Jenniges. Motion carried 3-0.
