AWARDING CONTRACT FOR PROJECT HANCOCK COUNTY SECOND-

### ARY ROADS MAINTENANCE FACILITY PHASE 1 WHEREAS. the Hancock Coun-

ty Board of Supervisors, hereafter referred to as "the Board", believes the Hancock County Secondary Roads Maintenance Facility Phase 1 Project, hereafter referred to as "the project" is in the best interest of Hancock County, Iowa, and the residents thereof. The project is defined as site grading and utility installation in preparation for a future maintenance building including site grading with soil import subgrade preparation, storm sewer installa-

tion, sanitary sewer force main installation, water service installation, granular subbase, seeding and erosion control. The site is located at 1020 Diagonal Street, Britt, Iowa; and

WHEREAS, the Board has sought appropriate professional guidance for the concept and planning for the project and followed the steps as required by the Code of lowa for notifications, hearings, and bidding/letting; and

WHEREAS, The Board finds this resolution appropriate and necessary to protect, preserve, and improve the rights, privileges, property, peace, safety, health, welfare, comfort, and convenience of Hancock County and its citizens, all as provided for in and permitted by section 331.301 of the Code of

Iowa; and IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED by Board to accept the bid from Reding's Gravel & Excavation Co. of Algona. Iowa in the amount of \$479,415.00 and awards the associated contract(s) to the same; BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED

WHEREAS, the Iowa Department of Transportation has adopted Administrative Rule 761 - Chapter 164, which created the Traffic Safetv Improvement Program (TSIP) to allow for funding to be provided to

WHEREAS, a study conducted at the intersection of Oak Avenue (R44) and 310th Street (B16) has determined that the installation of new flashing beacon traffic control devices will improve the safety of the traveling public; and

WHEREAS, flashing beacons are recognized traffic control devices in the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, 2009 Edition; and

WHEREAS, Hancock County has determined that providing portable rumble strips for use during maintenance activities will aid in improving safety for flaggers, maintenance workers, and the traveling public in road work zones; and
