## CITY OF CORWITH COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS December 22, 2020

The Corwith City Council met in special session on Tuesday, December 22, 2020 in the Corwith Public Library to adhere to the Governor's continued requirement to stay social distanced when gathering in a group setting. Mayor Hobscheidt called the meeting to order at 6:22 p.m. Council members present were: Fish, Hankins, Poage; Absent: Lloyd and Tindall.

Poage moved to approve the agenda, Fish second. Vote: AIF.

Council looked over and discussed the results from the water and sewer rate study that was conducted by IAMU. Hankins motioned to increase water rate to \$20.00 for the first 2,000 gallons and \$6.30 per 1,000-gallon overage. Sewer rate will increase to \$20.00 for the first 2,000 gallons and \$4.00 per 1,000-gallon overage for total gallons used, Poage second. Vote: AIF. Effective date of the rate increase is slated for July 1, 2021.

Clerk was instructed to move forward with the process and to make sure legal steps are followed with the rate increase.

Poage moved to adjourn the meeting, Fish second. Vote: AIF. Meeting was adjourned at 7:05 p.m.
