- Poage motioned to rescind approval of Waste Management Contract Termination letter, Lloyd second. Vote: AIF.
- Update was given on Wayne St. water pressure.
- Informed council of elections seats that will be up the re-election come November.
- Council set March 8th, 2021 at 6:15 for the FY2022 City Budget public hearing.
