PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE CITY OF CORWITH, IOWA

The City of Corwith will be holding two sequential public hearings at 6:15 p.m. on Tuesday, May 12, 2020 at the Corwith City Hall, 108 NW Elm St., Corwith. The first hearing will focus on developing a Community Development and Housing Needs Assessment (CDHNA). Input from the public is requested in identifying needs and projects to improve the city. Your comments can also be made by calling City Hall at 515-583-2342 or by emailing the City Clerk at cityofcorwith@comm1net.net, and as always you can stop by the office located at 108 NW Elm St. Corwith, Iowa to relay your comments. The second hearing will focus on input regarding the submission of a CDBG Exterior Home Improvement Grant application to the Iowa Economic Development Authority (IEDA) for the rehabilitation of the exterior of owner-occupied homes within the City of Corwith. The grant application is expected to be submitted by May 15, 2020 to the IEDA.

No persons or businesses will be permanently dislocated as a result of the project. The Mayor and City Council urge all interested parties to attend. Everyone will be invited to provide input. A representative from the North Iowa Area Council of Governments (NIACOG) will be available to respond to questions regarding the CDHNA and grant application.
