We, Brent Renner, Jon Hollatz, and Kent L. Rode, P.E., having previously filed oath, depose and say that we are the commissioners duly appointed to reclassify lands within the boundaries of Drainage District No 3 & 4, Lateral 10, Hancock County, Iowa.

Pursuant to said appointment, we have examined the Drainage District's records, as recorded by the Hancock County Auditor, to establish the original intended assessment boundary of this District. Any lands previously not recorded within the boundary of this District, but have been found to be receiving benefits from the facilities of this District, were annexed into the District. We have examined each quarter-quarter section or smaller tract of land and have classified each of these parcels. The percentage of benefit each parcel derives from the District's drainage facilities has been determined. There is only the Lateral 10 Schedule for this report.
