In support of Iowa Governor Kim Reynolds' proclamation declaring a State of Public Health Disaster Emergency in Iowa, the current COVID-19 Pandemic situation makes it impractical and impossible to conduct an in-person meeting at Garner City Hall to conduct City business, therefore this meeting was conducting in a "gotomeeting" format.
