Klemme City Council Proceedings

Monday February 1, 2021

The Klemme City Council met at the regular meeting on Monday February 1, at 6:30 PM, Community Room, City Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Blank. Present: Wolf, Boge-Miller, and Taft. Crotty, by teleconference.

Taft made a motion to accept the agenda. Crotty seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Boge-Miller made a motion to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Wolf seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Crotty made a motion, with a second from Taft, to approve the payment of the bills as presented. Motion carried.

The Sheriff's Report was reviewed.

Mayor Blank opened the public hearing for comments on the proposed property tax levy. There were no comments from the audience. Mayor Blank then closed the public hearing.

Wolf made a motion to approve Resolution #02-01-21, Acceptance of the Proposed Property Tax Dollars. Boge-Miller seconded the motion. Roll call was made with those voting Aye: Boge-Miller, Wolf, Taft and Crotty. Those voting Nay: None. Motion carried.

Taft made a motion, with a second from Boge-Miller to approve the contract with NIACOG to complete the comprehensive plan for the City for a fee of \$4,000.00 and complete a urban renewal plan for a fee of \$2,500.00. Motion carried.

Mayor Blank appointed Boge-Miller to be mayor Pro-Tem.

Taft made a motion to appoint Patt Ridder to the Zoning Board, for a 5 year term. Wolf seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Taft made a motion to appoint James Menke to fill the council vacancy. Wolf seconded the motion. Motion carried. Menke will serve until the next city election, unless a petition is filed to have an election.

Taft made a motion to accept City Clerk Rout's vacation request. Boge-Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Kenneth Weiland, Public Works Director, was present at the meeting.

Weiland informed the council that Bill with V&K had been in town to finalize the First Street and Day Street project. Iowa Rural Water had been in town just to check in on how things were going with the new lagoon system. Snow removal has been going good, and residents are keeping cars off the street until they are clean.

City Clerk, Colleen Rout, reviewed with the Council the changes that had been made to the 2021/2022 Budget, due to additional information being received.

Boge-Miller made a motion to set March 1, 2021 at 6:30 pm in the City Community Room at City Hall

to be the date, time, and place for the public budget hearing. Taft seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Taft made a motion, with a second from Boge-Miller to adjourn. Meeting adjourned. Colleen Rout, City Clerk/Treasurer
