

PROCEEDINGS: Klemme

Klemme City Council Proceedings Monday May 4, 2020

The Klemme City Council met at the regular meeting on Monday May 4, at 6:30 PM, Community Room, City Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Blank. Present: Trampel, Wolf, Crotty and Taft. Absent Welsh

Additions to the agenda were Clean-up Day, Resignation, Signs and Covid 19 effect on income.

Trampel made a motion to accept the agenda. Crotty seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Trampel made a motion to approve the minutes of the previous meetings. Crotty seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Trampel made a motion, with a second from Crotty to approve the payment of the bills as presented, with the exception of In-Step Flooring Motion carried.

The Sheriff's Report was reviewed.

Taft made a motion, with a second from Crotty, to hire Mosquito Control of Iowa to do the 2020 town spraying at a cost of \$2,685.00. Motion carried.

Kenneth Weiland informed the council that Klemme Ag Days for 2020 have been cancelled.

Kenneth Weiland, Public Works Director, was present at the meeting. Weiland asked the council if any of them had come up with streets that needed repair, as it was discussed in the April council meeting, to locate them. Weiland informed the council that Heartland would be coming to town to look at the streets sometime this week. Weiland will have someone repair or replace the gutter on the City shed.

Klemme Clean Up Day which is usually in May has been postponed. Will be looking at dates in the near future.

Trampel made a motion to accept the resignation of David Welsh from the Council. Crotty seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Crotty made a motion to fill the council vacancy by an appointment at the June 1 meeting. Trampel seconded the motion. Motion carried. The Clerk was instructed to post the "Notice of Intent to Fill Council Vacancy by Appointment" as required by state law.

The council inquired about getting some children at play signs, to be placed on some of the city streets here in town. Council asked Public Works Director Kenneth Weiland to look into if he had any on hand, and what the cost would be to purchase a couple.

Mayor Blank and City Clerk Rout had discussions about how the Covid 19 pandemic would affect the City's income. Klemme informed the council there would definitely be lower income from Local Option Sales Tax, along with Road Use Tax. With that information the City is not dismissing the cleaning up of junk vehicles

and properties but not taking legal action at this time due to the cost for attorney fees.

Trampel made a motion, with a second from Crotty, to adjourn. Meeting adjourned.
