Subject to the provisions of other county procedures and regulations, and applicable state law, the appropriations authorized under Section 1 shall constitute authorization for the department or officer listed to make expenditures or obligations from the itemized department effective July 1, 2025.

SECTION 3. In accordance with Section 331.437, Code of Iowa, no department or officer shall expend or contract to expend any money or incur any liability or enter into any contract which by its terms involves the expenditure of money for any purpose in excess of the amounts appropriated pursuant to this resolution.

SECTION 4. If at any time during the 2025-2026 budget year the auditor shall ascertain that the available resources of a department for that year will be less than said department's total appropriations, she shall immediately so inform the board and recommend appropriate corrective actions.

SECTION 5. The Auditor shall establish separate accounts for the appropriations authorized in Section 1, each of which account shall indicate the amount of the appropriation, the amounts charged thereto, and the unencumbered balance. The Auditor shall report the status of such accounts to the applicable departments and officers guarterly during the 2025-2026 budget year.

SECTION 6. All appropriations authorized pursuant to this resolution lapse at the close of business June 30, 2026. On motion by Supervisor Rayhons, seconded by Supervisor Jermeland and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following Resolution:

Resolution for Interfund Operational Transfers Authorizing periodic transfers from the General Basic Fund to the Conservation Fund; from General Basic Fund to Secondary Road Fund; from Rural Services Fund to the Secondary Road Fund; from Mokry Trust Fund to the General Basic Fund

Resolution to authorize the Hancock County Auditor to periodically transfer sums in accordance with Section 331.432 Code of Iowa from the General Basic Fund to the Conservation Fund not to exceed \$462,000, from the General Basic Fund to the Secondary Road Fund not to exceed \$93,006, from the Rural Services Fund to the Secondary Road Fund not to exceed \$2,321,881, and from the Mokry Trust Fund to General Basic Fund not to exceed \$33,000 all in Fiscal Year 2025-2026.
